

REVERSIR: A Generalizable Platform to Restore Activity of Target mRNA

- Although clinical data do not indicate the need for a reversal agent,^{1,2} the long-acting nature of zilebesiran has prompted questions on how short-term reversal may be managed³
- REVERSIR (RVR) is a reverse siRNA silencing technology that is being researched to counteract siRNA-mediated pharmacodynamic effects⁴
- **Therapeutic Hypothesis:** The RVR molecule targets siRNAs so that their recognition and silencing of mRNA is blocked, and protein production may resume⁴
